PURPOSE

This conference is conducted for educational and informational purposes. Sales activities are not permitted by exhibitors. Exhibitors are encouraged to explain, show, or demonstrate products or services where appropriate for your organization/business.

BRANDED LOGO & ARTWORK

All logo or artwork to be submitted to the Director of Corporate Sponsorships for use on website, print/digital media, or custom items must be submitted by Feb. 16 to be guaranteed inclusion in conference materials. Images should be a 300-dpi minimum. Transparent backgrounds are preferable (but not required).

EXHIBIT EQUIPMENT

Virginia DECA will provide a 6-foot draped table and 2 chairs. The fee DOES NOT INCLUDE labor, shipping charges, special lighting, Internet connections, or electrical connections. The exhibit space will be in the Leadership Village, 2nd Floor. Exhibitors will be notified by **VA DECA** if the location changes.

The use of devices for mechanical reproduction of sound is prohibited. Sound of any kind must not be projected outside the booth. Motion pictures, slide demonstrations, fashion shows, Karaoke, etc. are subject to prior approval by Virginia DECA.

SET UP AND REMOVAL OF EXHIBITS

Exhibitors may begin setup at 9:00AM on Friday March 1, 2024 and should be prepared for exhibits to open by 11:00AM. Should additional time be needed, contact VA DECA. Exhibits are to remain open until 2:00PM on Saturday, March 2, 2024 and removed by 3:00PM.

SECURITY

Virginia DECA will NOT provide security during the hours the exhibit area is closed. The exhibitor is solely responsible for his/her own exhibit material and should insure his/her exhibit against loss or damage. Virginia DECA will work with convention center staff to lock the exhibit area at the close of the exhibit times.

BADGES

Exhibitors will be provided with badges to permit entry to the exhibit area. You must advise us of attending personnel by February 23, 2024, so that badges can be prepared in advance. All exhibitors must register and pick up their conference packets at the Information Booth in the Convention Center lobby on-site.
